2010 Architecture Scholarship Information

Scholarship Purpose:

Frisbie Architects is celebrating their 13th anniversary in business this year. This scholarship is to honor that achievement by giving back to the profession. We also hope to encourage students living or attending school in Pierce or St. Croix Counties to pursue their dream of becoming an architect. Over the past several years, enrollment at architecture schools has declined. As baby boomers retire, there will be fewer well-qualified architects to take their place. This scholarship will support a student as he/she pursues a bachelor or masters of architecture at an accredited architecture school.

Scholarship Amount: One scholarship for \$1,000, renewable for up to an additional four years.

Criteria for the first year of the award:

- The student must live or attend school in Pierce or St. Croix County if he/she is a senior in high school. If a college student is applying for the award, the student must have graduated from a Pierce or St. Croix county school.
- The student must have at least a 3.0 GPA.
- The student must be enrolled at an accredited architecture school in the United States, with first preference going to Montana State University and North Dakota State University. Any other accredited college is fine as well. For a list of accredited architecture schools, go to: http://www.naab.org/architecture_programs/
- Student must attend college full time.
- Student will have a short interview with Frisbie Architects' staff.

Criteria for continuing to receive the scholarship in consecutive years:

- The scholarship will continue as long as the student maintains a 3.0 GPA, attends school full time, and takes architecture classes at an accredited architecture school.
- At the end of each school year, the scholarship recipient will send Frisbie Architects their transcript and a copy of their fall class schedule to document this.
- If the student meets the criteria, the scholarship is available for four consecutive years at a four-year program, or for five consecutive years at a five-year program.
- The scholarship recipient is encouraged to stop in and visit us each summer.
- The student receiving the scholarship will be encouraged (but not required) to apply to Frisbie Architects for working on summer breaks and an architectural internship if the firm has a position available.

Payment:

- For the first year of college, full payment will be made upon successful completion of first quarter/semester. For the following years, payment will be made about one month prior to the first semester.
